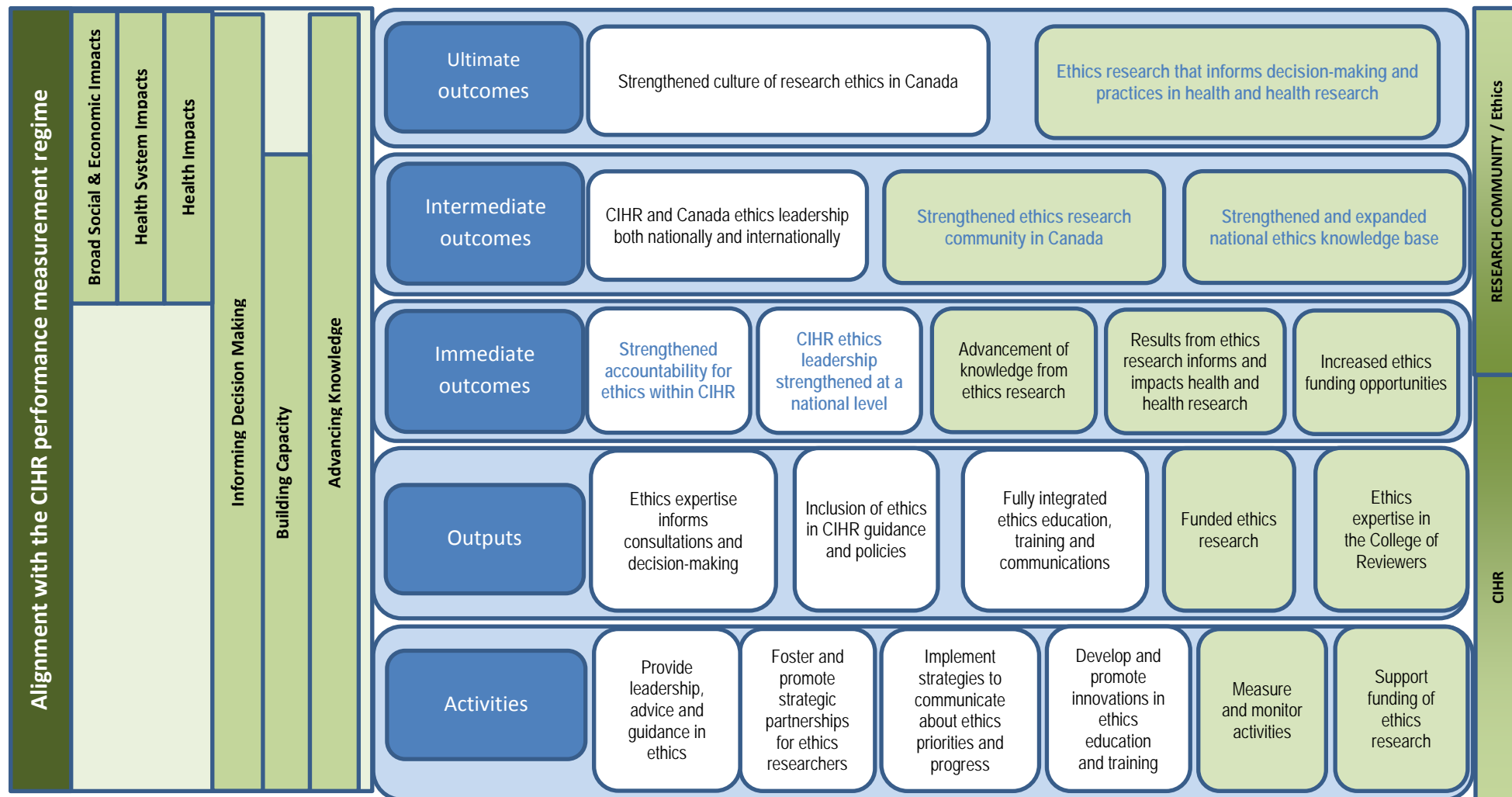


CIHR Ethics Logic Model and link to the CIHR performance measurement regime ¹

Promote, assist and undertake research that meets the highest international scientific standards of excellence and ethics, foster the discussion of ethical issues and the application of ethical principles to health research, and monitor the discussion of ethical issues.

Outputs – The direct products or services generated from the activities of an organization, policy, program or initiative.

Immediate outcomes – An outcome that is directly attributable to the outputs delivered.

Intermediate outcomes – Outcomes that are logically expected to occur once one or more immediate outcomes have been achieved.

Ultimate outcomes – These are the highest-level outcomes that can be reasonably and causally attributed to a policy, program or initiative. These are a consequence of one or more intermediate outcomes having been achieved.

Green shading = “Ethics research” stream
 White shading = “Culture of ethics” stream
 Blue font = transformative outcomes, to be monitored and reported against.
