As a partner in this research funding competition, you will:

- Provide 1:1 matching funding to support high-quality, high-impact research that will make a difference in the lives of Canadians

Research funding details:

- Grant recipients will receive up to \$70,000 per year, for three years (2020–2023)
- CIHR will provide half of this funding, the partner(s) will provide the other half (up to \$35,000 per year for three years)
- Partner(s) could be a charitable organization, philanthropic foundation, or industry partner, among others

Competition applicants:

- Are within 60 months of their first independent academic appointment
- Are formally affiliated with an eligible institution
- Have not received operating grant funding of more than \$500,000 as a principal investigator

Since this annual competition started in 2017, **59 early career investigators** have been funded. Their research ranges from investigating infections in pregnancy to identifying resilience factors in First Nations children and youth.
